Student Basketball Night at LPMS

March 9, 2018

Rules

Our **Twelfth Annual Basketball Night** will be held on **Friday, March 9, 2018 from 5:30 – 9:00** p.m. in the gymnasium at LPMS. General admission tickets are \$3 per person. Dinner and refreshments will be sold beginning at 5:00 p.m. Please join us for dinner and come out to watch our students play!!!

1) Basketball Games – Registered teams will play from the same grade against each other until a champion emerges.

To play, teams must follow these rules:

- Teams must be comprised of 8-10 players
- Teams must have a Coach (please provide Coach's email on Team Registration form)
- Teams must have a Parent Representative (please provide Parent Representative's email on Registration form) and the Team Parent Representative **MUST** attend Basketball Night
- Teams can register during lunchtime on **Tuesday, February 20th, Thursday, February 22nd, Tuesday, February 27th** and **Thursday, March 1st**. All players must pay the \$5 registration fee.
- Completed paperwork, with fees, may be dropped off in the Main Office, in an envelope marked BASKETBALL NIGHT, and **MUST** include the Student's name and the Team's name
- *Registration Deadline for all paperwork and fees is **Friday, March 2nd***
- Teams can be comprised of boys and girls from the same grade level
- Teams must have a name (may be modified by the Committee as appropriate)
- Teams can have Team T-shirts, if they so choose, as long as they are not taunting, negative or offensive. T-shirts can be self-made or purchased and is totally up to the team's discretion
- Teams may **not have more than 3 LPMS boy basketball players** or **4 LPMS Girl Basketball players** on any basketball night team
- Players must have completed and turned in a player permission slip, signed by a parent, as well as their \$5 entrance fee, BY March 8th. Each team must turn in one Team Registration form
- The first team at each grade level that turn in complete paperwork (team registration, individual permission and money) will be awarded a 2 point lead in their first bracket game.

2) This is a FUNdraiser, the net proceeds of which will benefit the City of Gaithersburg's Delores Swoyer Camp Scholarship Fund and our LPMS PTSA.

3) This is a family event and all families, spouses, siblings, etc., (including the Coach's), are welcome to attend. No food is permitted in the gym.

If you are interested in forming a Basketball Night team, please complete the registration form and turn it in on the above mentioned days during lunch, (or in the Main Office), along with each team member's own permission slip and own \$5 fee, (cash or check payable to "LPMS PTSA"). This should be a fun night for all!
